

World History A Funko POP! Doll Mini-Project

On the back of this sheet is a template for the front and back of a box of one of those insanely popular POP! Dolls by the Funko toy company. Your assignment is to design a Funko POP! Doll based on one of the people involved in the events of Module 18. You can pick any person who was instrumental in the Scientific Revolution, the Enlightenment, the spread of the enlightenment, or the American Revolution/Founding Fathers of the United States. You will start by drawing the doll on the large template on the left and labeling its 'series'. There is space for the doll's name underneath. On the right side you can fill in a synopsis of the person's life, and in the "Collect Them All" box, you will design 2 dolls that represent people associated with the one you chose (For instance, if I was designing a doll around Catherine the Great, my "Collect Them All" dolls would be Frederick the Great of Prussia and Joseph II of Austria, as they are all Enlightened Despots!) 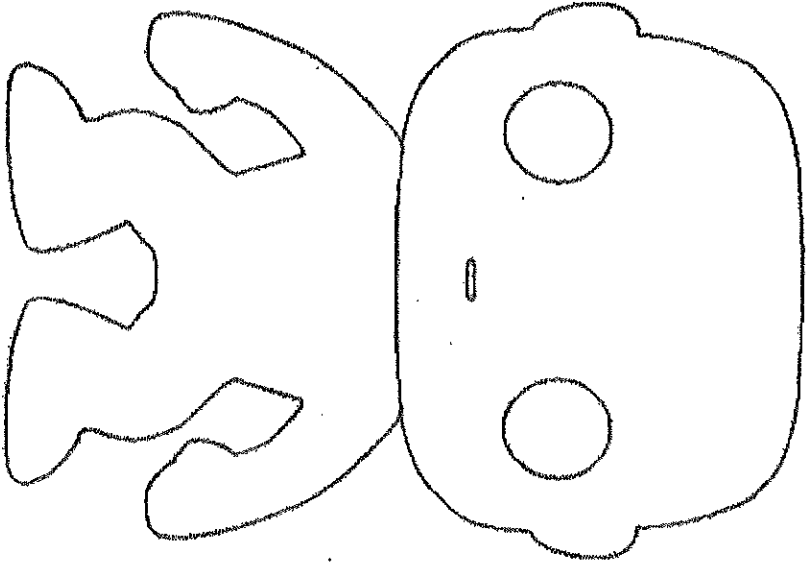

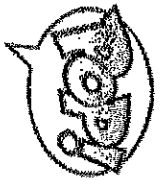
